- Visit all of the nursing homes within your local area
- Initiate evangelistic outdoor crusades in neighborhoods of great need
- Participate in community outreach efforts that promote the church and outreach events

How do you start an actively engaged outreach team within your church?

To fulfill Ephesians 5:12 by “the equipping of the saints for the work of service.” My desire is help your people to be **trained, equipped, mobilized and ignited on fire** to demonstrate the power of the gospel while learning that they can very powerfully be used by God to see whole communities changed by the power of the gospel.

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1. **YOU WILL FULFILL THE GREAT COMMISSION!**

You will preach the gospel of Jesus Christ to the lost and through this you will see people experience a fresh touch of God through salvation, deliverance and healing.

2. **YOUR HEART WILL BE SET ON FIRE!**

When you (harvester) lead a person to Jesus, cast out devils or witness people getting healed before your very eyes, you can't help but be lit on fire for God.

3. **YOUR CHURCH WILL BE IGNITED AND SET ON FIRE!**

As you spread the news of your new found passion for soul winning your church will witness this and hear the reports of souls being won to Jesus on their streets and they will catch and adapt the culture of soul winning. Your church will be known as a soul-winning church across this region

RESPONSIBILITIES

RESPONSIBILITIES of those who participate in the outreaches

To accomplish the great commission we must be unified and be available to minister to one another. Our job here on earth is to preach the good news of Jesus, release people from the clutches of the kingdom of darkness through the Gospel of Jesus Christ, connect them to the Father heart of God and be an eyewitness of heaven reaching out for that one lost sheep! Here are some of the responsibilities to help us walk in unity.

A. EVANGELISM MINISTRY and EVANGELISM TEAM mutually agree:

1. To seek God with all of our hearts.
2. To pray and lift up our Pastor's hands.
3. To walk in the fruit of the Spirit. To edify and NOT tear down.
4. To attend church as much as possible (unless gravely sick or dead).
5. Be a tither and a giver. Support the funding of the end time harvest.

B. EVANGELISM MINISTRY agrees:

1. Pray for the Evangelism team.
2. Provide a challenging atmosphere where people can grow and expand their soul winning abilities.
3. Be available to team members 24/7 for prayer, outreach ideas, ministry or whatever is needed.
4. Provide times of refreshing and fellowship (off duty).

C. EVANGELISM TEAM agrees:

1. To pray for Evangelism Leadership

2. While on the streets:

- a. Follow the instructions of the team leader.
- b. Properly represent Jesus and your Church.
- c. Be safe. Go two by two. Always know where your partner is.
- d. Do not enter into anyone's house unless praying for the sick.
- e. When laying hands on Women/Men use wisdom.
- f. DO lay hands on the sick but always with their permission.
- g. DO NOT get follow-up information from children.
- h. Men should not approach children alone unless permission by the parent.
- i. DO NOT enter fenced in areas that say "Beware of Dog" duh!
- j. If you don't feel at peace at a certain place, then leave immediately!.
- k. If you get "thrown out" of one place go to the next.
- l. Use the Gospel Soul-Winning Script.
- m. Support evangelism follow-up functions (Phone calls, discipleship, fellowships, etc.)
- n. Enjoy yourself, you're plundering hell and populating heaven!

3. While at Nursing Homes:

1. Follow the instructions of the team leader.
2. DO NOT take down ANY NAMES of patients which is a violation of HIPPA Law.
3. Wear your name tags. This makes staff and patients comfortable.
4. Pray for the sick and EXPECT MIRACLES TO HAPPEN!
5. Don't spend too much time with one patient. Search and Rescue!
6. Shake em & Wake em (respectively), at times patients sleep because they are bored.
7. Use the Nursing Home Gospel Script

PROFICIENCY LEVELS

Being of a military background I was tested, trained and measured through proficiency guidelines. Each person will be trained on individual tasks which are clearly defined, observable, and measurable establishing a solid foundation.. These tasks enable Harvesters to master the necessary skills.and rise to the next level.

1. FIRST TIME ATTENDEE – PROFICIENCY LEVEL: 3 – TITLE: TRAINEE

1. Attend Outreach Training Session.
2. Observe Outreach Activities and Engage in Winning Souls
3. Follow Established Outreach Rules
4. Accountable to Assigned Soul Winner

2. Established SOUL WINNER – PROFICIENCY LEVEL: 5 – TITLE: HARVESTER

1. Pray for Outreaches and Leadership
2. Attend All Training Sessions
3. Lead People to Jesus through the Gospel Soul-Winning Script
4. Follow Established Outreach Rules
5. Train New People When Appointed
6. Accountable to Outreach Leader

3. OUTREACH LEADER – PROFICIENCY LEVEL: 7 – TITLE: OUTREACH LEADER

1. Prays for Harvesters, Team Members & Future Laborers
2. Provides Direction for Assigned Outreach
 - a. Maps Out the Location of a Primary, Secondary & Hit and Run Location
3. Prepare for Outreaches
 - a. Show up ½ hour before, make copies of outreach materials and assembles clipboards
4. Conducts Training
 - a. Leads Evangelism Training Class using the Evangelism Training Notebook
5. Appoints
 - a. Multiple Outreach Teams if a larger number of 6 to 8 harvesters attend.
 - b. Harvester Teams (2 or 3 people to a team)
6. Monitors
 - a. Success level - Breaks off & checks during half-way point.
 - b. Harvesters for safety, needs and feedback as to the success of the outreach.
 - c. New people to make sure they receive a positive experience and reassign if needed.
7. Fills out Team Leader Report sheet collects any unused materials.
8. Train and promote proven harvesters to the position of team leader. The individual will demonstrate characteristics of being willing, faithful, effective and full of the fire of God.
9. Accountable to Director

4. DIRECTOR - PROFICIENCY LEVEL: 9 - TITLE: DIRECTOR OF EVANGELISM

- a) Coordinates All Activities and Initiate New Outreaches
- c) Train and promote team leaders to the position of director. The individual will demonstrate characteristics of being passionate, responsible, possessing leadership qualities, detailed, consistent, faithful and a visionary.
- d) Provides fellowship functions and activities.provides weekly statistics to pastor
- e) Provide 1 copy of each prayer cards to Prayer Team, Followup Team and Church Administration
- f) Provide weekly soul report cards and any notable testimonies to the pastor before next outreach
- f) Accountable to Senior Pastor
